## **Gain Experience Working with Children at a Non-Profit Summer Youth Program**

### **July 3 – August 24, 2018**

#### **Internship Description**

##### Purpose:

The mission of the Summer Youth Program at CPAH is to provide safe, enriching, and educational activities for resident youth. Engaging activities and crafts, as well as weekly field trips and presentations are available to youth living at any one of CPAH's low-income family apartment complexes. Dedicated staff, interns and volunteers supervise activities and trips and serve as positive role models. This Summer Youth Program is facilitated by the Volunteers of America.

##### Tasks:

- Plan games and activities for youth to participate in.
- Help supervise activities, crafts and free lunch program.
- Supervise small groups (3-5 kids) during field trips.
- Support program rules and discipline.
- Assist the program staff in daily routines.
- Set positive examples for program students.

##### Other possible activities:

- Prepare and assist with backpacks and school supplies project.

##### Hours and duration:

20 hours per week during the eight-week Summer Youth Program. Total: 160 hours.

This program will be divided into two different back-to-back Summer Youth Programs. Our first program will be at a Tigard property from July 3- July 27, and the second program will be at our Beaverton property from July 31- August 24.

##### Stipend:

\$800/month upon successful completion of the internship.
